



SURVEY RESULTS

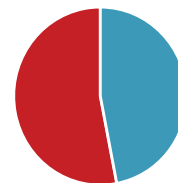
Tahltan Band members were recently given a survey and asked to give their opinions on the Land Code. This survey was handed out at community meetings in Dease Lake and Telegraph Creek. It was also made available online for three weeks. This is what we heard:

WHO COMPLETED THE SURVEY?

58 Respondents

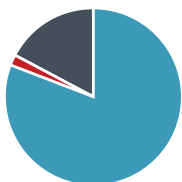
Do you live on an Iskut Band reserve?



● Yes - 48%
● No - 52%

WHAT DID THEY SAY?

Do you think Iskut Band should be able to manage our own reserve lands and pass our own laws?



● Yes - 81%
● No - 2%
● Unsure - 17%

Which of the following do you feel is the most important opportunity from having a Land Code?



We will have the ability to protect areas of environmental and cultural significance on our reserves – **54%**



Only the laws and policies we create will apply on reserve, not the Indian Act – **17%**



The community will be the decision makers about how the reserves can be developed – **12%**



Chief and Council will be more accountable to members and will have to disclose all financial decisions – **10%**

WHAT ARE MEMBERS SAYING?



"This sounds like a great opportunity for our people. It is going to be a slow process and we will need to train our people for this."

Which of the following is most important for us to think about and discuss before we take this step?



It takes time, laws and policies do not get developed over night – **28%**



We will be assuming all responsibility for new environmental issues on reserve after a Land Code takes effect – **24%**

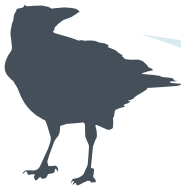


There is no turning back to the Indian Act after a Land Code takes effect – **23%**

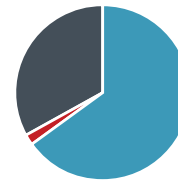


"How do I get more info on the land code and what is the big picture plan or view of this subject?"

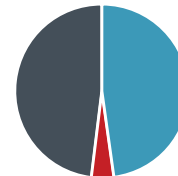
