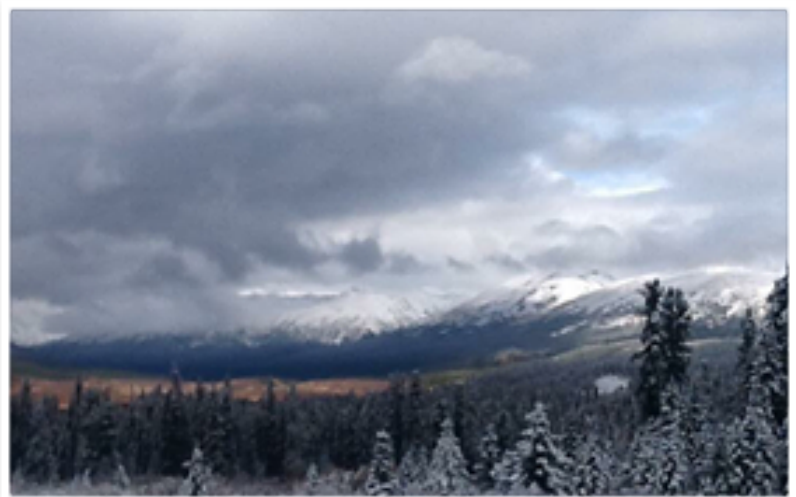
Introducing the Iskut Community Advisory Board
