RE: UPDATE ON THE 2021 ELECTION OF ISKUT COUNCILLORS

The purpose of this letter is to update you regarding the election process currently underway for the Iskut First Nation.

As your appointed Electoral Officer, I facilitated a Nomination Meeting on the evening of Thursday, September 9 in the Iskut Community Hall.

At the end of the meeting, there were not enough nominees put forward to fill the six Councillor seats of the Iskut Band Council whose term expires later this year.

It was decided that another Nomination Meeting (see other side for details) will be held to provide an opportunity for additional nominees to be added to the list of potential candidates provided they meet the eligibility criteria as described on the Notice.

The criteria includes providing a recent criminal record check to me within five business days of the nomination meeting (per Section 8.8 of the Iskut Band Custom Election Code), as well as a recent amendment now requiring nominees to be of Tahltan ancestry in order to be considered as a candidate.

A copy of the Iskut Band Custom Election Code is available on the Iskut Band Council website along with other useful information for members like yourself.
